## Group Member Evaluation

In the space provided below, please **evaluate each group member** by assigning a score ranging from 0 to 10. This number is to be based on the *quality* and *quantity* of effort put forth by each person. If you give someone a score less than 10, you must explain why in the space provided for comments below (the scores you give and any comments you provide will remain confidential and only the instructor will get to see them). Your personal group evaluation score is your average score from everyone else in the group (rounded to the nearest whole number). If 6 or lower, your group homework and statistics in action (and/or project) scores will be adjusted downwards using the following percentages (subject to the instructor's discretion):
